



SCHOOL PRESENTATION - CHECKLIST FOR THE SHOW

Ian should arrive at your location 30-45 minutes prior to the presentation. In that time Ian will conduct a sound check, and look over the staging etc. Ian hopes to meet briefly with you and your administration prior to the show to confirm the assembly procedures. The presentation is designed to be 65 minutes in length, anything you can do to insure that amount of time is allotted (after the loading and unloading of students) will guarantee a more “full” presentation for your school/conference.

The following is a list of things to be in place prior to the presentation at your school.

- 1.** Please have a working, tested, quality sound system with a microphone (*hand held preferred*) ***THIS IS THE MOST IMPORTANT ITEM FOR A SUCCESSFUL ASSEMBLY.*** The sound system MUST have inputs for an MP3 player (which Ian will bring). If it is a wired microphone please insure there is adequate cable for Ian to move freely the length and depth of the stage. The more stage space the better. For a wireless mic, please insure batteries are fresh/fully charged.
- 2.** A cheque for the balance of the presentation fee and expenses, payable to ***“YLCC (Memo – CYSB).”***
- 3.** A printed copy of Ian’s Introduction, and a student or teacher who will be reading it.
- 4.** A student’s desk (or a small table) and chair will need to be placed at centre-rear of the stage area, with 2 Small bottles of water.


For a “Hero Inside” Presentation:

A student or teacher volunteer to start Ian’s music cues, and a few extra minutes to go over the cues with them prior to the show (easy job – anyone can do it!!!).

For a “Hooray For Everything!” Presentation:

An additional 4 chairs on stage (which Ian will arrange), and a whisk broom.
If there is a chance of building a few extra minutes at the end of the presentation that would be fantastic. Ian enjoys being able to meet with the students after the presentation. *One final aspect of a quality presentation is making sure that teachers are scattered amongst the students to insure proper behaviour and etiquette during the assembly.* We realize that all schools have different rules, but if phones and/or computers players could be turned off during the presentation that would be great! Thanks for your cooperation.
